- Strengthen opportunities with other CSP partners to prevent and reduce re-offending through managing and understanding the impact of adverse childhood experiences, adult trauma, and poor mental health.

Prepare – identify and stop individuals re-offending quickly and mitigate the impact on our communities where it occurs.

- Ensure that the needs analysis data relating to reoffending is included in the Annual CSP Strategic Assessment of Crime and Disorder to inform priorities and workplans.
- Disseminate the new segmentation data annually to CSP partners.

Protect - recognise the causes of SOC / exploitation and identify the available measures to reduce risk.

- Review awareness raising across high-risk individuals within communities for current cybercrime threats and how to protect against them.
- Continue to develop a sub-regional all-age exploitation strategy.
- Provide training to the multi-agency workforce to identify and report Serious and Organised Crime.

Prepare - Stop exploitation and SOC quickly and mitigate the impact of it on our communities where it occurs.

- Ensure there is coordinated governance arrangements for exploitation and SOC that enable partners to respond robustly across all age groups.
- Explore further opportunities to develop trauma informed services, counselling, and other funded interventions, and look to understand the subsequent impact within partner organisations.

Prepare - Stop ASB quickly and mitigate the impact of ASB on our communities where it occurs.

- Deliver partnership ASB Board with agreed priorities and actions.
- Use the ASB Dashboard to target strategic and operational responses to ASB.
- Deliver a multiagency ASB Problem Solving Groups (PSGs) for each Local Policing Units (LPUs) area to coordinate a problem solving approach to localised issues.

- Disrupt and dismantle organised crime groups involved in the transport and supply of controlled substances.

Protect - understand the root causes of substance misuse and work with partners to reduce the associated risks.

- Report to the CSP on the Specialist Drugs and Alcohol Treatment Service, the Combating Drugs Partnership and the Homeless Commission for Cheshire West and Chester.
- Maintain strong links with the drugs related death panel, and report findings back to CSP.
- Contribute with CSP partners to the drug and alcohol joint strategic needs assessment and target appropriate interventions at areas of risk.

Prepare - mitigate the impact of substances misuse on our communities where it occurs.

- Monitor and address the issues around Drug Related Litter.

- Implement, monitor, and review a partnership Domestic Abuse Action Plan linked to the strategy and the Home Office Domestic Abuse plan.
- Maintain an intelligence picture and prioritise support to the most vulnerable who have been subject to the highest levels of harm within our communities.
